Guidelines for Requesting a Specialty/Booster



Statement of Purpose

The purpose for holding a Specialty Show under the authority of the Siberian Husky of Canada is to celebrate and promote the Siberian Husky, and to do so in a manner worthy of the name. A specialty show, whether it be a large, flamboyant and expensive affair, or a small, bare-bones event, must meet basic standards as determined by the National Club and the Canadian Kennel Club.

All CKC and SHCC rules and regulations and policies and procedures shall be adhered to. The **Show Secretary** has the *responsibility* and the *power* to ensure that all SHCC and CKC rules, regulations,

ByLaws, Policies and Procedures and financial considerations are complied with.

Application Procedure

- 1. Specialty/Booster Application Form, must be submitted to the SHCC Vice President a minimum of 10 months prior to the event.
- 2. A separate form is completed for each specialty and/or booster.
- 3. The Show Chairperson must be a SHCC and CKC member in good standing.
- 4. The Show Superintendent, Show Secretary and Chief Ring Steward may be provided by the host club.
- 5. Venue is the site or grounds where the event will be held.
- 6. If the event is a combined Club effort, the alternate Club approval letter must accompany the Application.
- 7. If the venue is in a geographic area other than that of the host SHCC area, then a signed letter of approval from the 2nd SHCC area is attached.
- 8. See Financial plan procedure
- 9. The Show Chairperson signs the Application form to indicate understanding of SHCC and CKC requirements.

Financial Plan

1. All costs associated with

venue; judges: payment, transportation, accommodation, gifts, trophies: purchase, transportation, labeling; prizes; ribbons; catalog; advertizing; hospitality; etc.

- 2. Fundraising
- 3. Rebates from host club,
- 4. Income from entries
- 5. Donations
- 6. etc.

Show Plan As per CKC and SHCC rules and regulations.

Classes to be offered: both official & unofficial, including sweeps, parades, junior handling etc.

Judges, regular and non-regular classes, sweepstakes, unofficial, junior handling etc.

Reserved grooming/hospitality area

These guidelines are not all inclusive and are to be used as such.



SHCC EVENT REQUESTS

Events can be conformation specialties, boosters; obedience; rally-o; agility; sled races; fun matches; sanctioned matches; fun races; etc.

This events list is representative but not all inclusive.

Siberian Husky Club of Canada Executive permission must be granted for any event being held under the SHCC banner.

All requests are to be sent to the SHCC Vice President.

Based on SHCC Executive decision the VP will forward the completed and signed event request to the appropriate SHCC Director.
